




Match the Frontier Facts

Battle of the Lees


- Studying philosophy in college taught me that being prepared is the best way to avoid a fight, not start one. (Bruce Lee)

- I once said, "If the enemy is cool, stay cooler than him. If the enemy moves, move faster than him." (Bruce Lee)


